The **Level 3 Diploma in Complementary Therapies** is a technical level qualification that provides learners with the knowledge, understanding and skills to work as an employed or self employed therapist. The content of this qualification is comprised of all the required elements to work effectively as a complementary therapist: anatomy, physiology and pathology, principles and practice of complementary therapies including health and safety, client care, client consultation and business principles. .

You will study the following units whist on this course;

- Business practice for complementary therapies
- Principles and practice of complementary therapies
- Knowledge of anatomy, physiology and pathway for complementary therapies
- Provide body massage for complementary therapies
- Provide aromatherapy for complementary therapies
- Provide reflexology for complementary therapies

Entry Requirements: A Level 2 Diploma in Complementary Therapies and Level 2 English qualification are required. Acceptance onto this course is subject to successful guidance interview & assessment test.

Assessment: A portfolio of work is to be submitted for moderation.
