

Level 2 Certificate in Supporting Teaching & Learning



The **Level 2 Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning** has been designed to provide you with an understanding of the knowledge and skills needed when working directly with children and young people in school or college environments as a teaching assistant. This qualification covers a wide range of areas including children and young people's development, supporting children and young people's positive behaviour and communication and professional relationships. It is aimed at learners working in roles that support pupils' learning in primary, secondary or special schools, as well as colleges.

You will study the following units as part of your course:

- Understand the role of schools and colleges
- Understand children and young people's development and their safeguarding
- Maintain relationships with children and young people including equality & diversity
- Support positive behaviour in a learning environment for children and young people
- Promote an effective learning environment and provide displays with / for children

You will need to be working or on a practical placement for the duration of the course in a learning environment (school or college etc), as you will need to show competence in both skills and knowledge.

Entry Requirements: You will need to be working at Level 1 for English / ESOL and have good level of written and spoken English. Acceptance onto this course is subject to successful guidance interview & assessment test.

Assessment: A portfolio of work will be submitted for moderation along with practical observations during your placement.

Progression Route: On completion of this course you may choose progress onto the Level 3 Certificate or Diploma in Supporting Teaching and Learning, or move into a job in the education sector.
