

Level 3 Diploma in Counselling Skills

This qualification is ideal for those seeking to enhance their functional role through the use of counselling skills. Learners will gain an understanding of a range of counselling skills and have the opportunity to examine some of the various schools of thought/theoretical models associated with them. This qualification does not qualify learners to practise as a counsellor. This qualification is suitable for learners aged 16 and above.

You will study the following units as part of your course:

- Theoretical approaches in the use of counselling skills
- Working ethnically with counselling skills
- Counselling skills and diversity
- Counselling skills and personal development

This qualification does not qualify learners to practise as a counsellor.
