Level 4 Certificate in Education & Training

The **Level 4 Certificate in Education and Training** develops practical teaching skills and prepares teachers to work in a wide range of contexts. It requires observation and assessment of practice. This qualification aims to meet the needs of a range of trainee teachers, such as individuals not currently in a teaching or training role, individuals currently teaching and training (including those who have just begun teaching and training) and individuals currently working as Assessors who wish to achieve a qualification that provides an introduction to teaching.

You will study a range of units covering aspects of education & training including:

- Understanding roles, responsibilities and relationships in education and training U
- Delivering education and training
- Using resources for education and training
- Assessing learners in education and training
- Planning to meet the needs of learners in education and training

This qualification requires learners to undertake a practical placement.

Entry Requirements: You will need to be 19+ and have a Level 2 in Maths and English or be working towards them.

Acceptance onto this course is subject to successful guidance interview & assessment test.

Assessment: A portfolio of work is to be submitted for moderation.

Awarding Body: NCFE

Progression Route: Once you have completed this course, you can progress onto the Level 5 Diploma in Education and Training or go straight into employment.
